What is Enriched Housing at Ken-Ton Presbyterian Village?

An affordable alternative to Assisted Living, the Enriched Housing Services program at Ken-Ton Presbyterian Village is a program of care and service that allows for individuals living in our Ken-Ton Presbyterian Village to maintain an independent lifestyle by providing housekeeping, laundry services, shower assistance and meals.

We are a non-medical program overseen by the New York State Department of Health.



Your Affordable Home:

- Your HUD, subsidized unfurnished senior apartment rent is based on 30% of gross income
- Includes a living room, one bedroom, handicapped accessible kitchen, entryway, and bathroom with a walk-in shower
- Small dog or cat allowed with pet deposit
- Secured entrance to building
- Electric stove and refrigerator provided
- Individually controlled heating & air conditioning (electric)
- Smoke detectors & heat sensors
- Emergency pull cord in 3 locations in apartment
- Wi-Fi provided in common areas of building



Enriched Housing Program (EHP)

What is the cost?



In addition to your monthly rent the cost of services for the EHP are determined by your income and assets. We do accept SSI.

Program hours for the EHP staff are 8-4pm, 7 days a week and the services provided are:

- Housekeeping provided weekly by our personal care aides. Toilet paper is provided to residents.
- Laundry services are done by our personal care aide weekly, 2 loads per resident.
- Shower assistance by our personal care aides who can assist the resident with showering 1-3 times per week.
- Meals: A hot congregate meal is provided & served in the EHP Dining Room. The NYS DOH requires EHP residents to attend and eat their noon meal in the dining room.
- Each day, residents order foods that are delivered to their apartment for breakfast & supper.



QUALIFICATIONS

for Enriched Housing Program

- Persons 55 years of age or older
- Program does **not** assist with medication administration; must be independent in medication management or have something in place that assists, such as family or an agency
- Must be able to ambulate independently (walkers are permitted and may use a wheelchair or scooter for distance)
- Must be free of communicable disease
- If moving into a 2nd floor unit, must be able to descend one flight of stairs to the floor below in an emergency
